- 1:00 pm Visit the Charles H. Wright Museum of African American History. Enjoy a docent led tour through "And Still We Rise: Our Journey through African American History and Culture."

Fourth Day

Monday May 22, 2023

- 8:00 am Breakfast at your hotel.
- 10:00 am Take part in a tour led by Niagara Bound Tours. Your Tour Guide, Lezlie will meet you at your hotel. Your tour will relive the history through the era of the underground railroad to present day throughout the Niagara area.
The first stop is the area where the people involved in the Niagara Movement of 1905 visited. One of the results of this meeting was the formation of the NAACP.
Next, you will visit the area where many a Freedom Seeker first felt freedom after crossing the Niagara River. Among them was Josiah Henson, the character believed to be the one used in Harriet Beecher Stowe's Uncle Tom's Cabin. Hear his story and his great contributions to Canada.
Visit a small secluded cemetery where former slaves are buried including your guides ancestors.
- 12:15 pm Then you will travel along the Niagara Parkway to British Methodist Episcopal Church where bagged lunches will be there waiting for the students.
After you leave the church, you will drive by the site owned by a man who ended up in St. Catharines after having been an enslaved person in the United States from Africa.
Next, visit the grave of Anthony Burns. Hear his story which occurred during the Fugitive Slave Act era.
You will drive through Niagara on the Lake which was the first capital of Canada. It was also named the prettiest town in Canada. Most importantly it is where the Anti-Slave Act of 1793 was signed which began the start of abolition of slavery in this country.
- 4:30 pm Ride the Hornblower Cruise Niagara. Get as close as possible to the breathtaking flow of water, power and mist that is the magnificent Niagara Falls (weather permitting).
Dinner tonight will be at Boston Pizza on Clifton Hill. After dinner there will be time to play the arcades (25 tokens will be provided to each student).
