

Seeking Shelter

- Students/Families
 - Contact the Office of Homeless Services (OHS) Prevention, Diversion and Intake team to discuss available homeless assistance programs.
 - Call the Homelessness Prevention Hotline @ 215-686-7177 and follow the instructions.
 - Visit a City-funded <u>INTAKE CENTER</u>.
 - Children are not required to be with the head of household when visiting one of the intake sites when requesting shelter placement assistance.
 - If a family needs immediate shelter after hours they can report to the designated after hours shelters.
- Unaccompanied Youth
 - Contact a Youth Designated Access Point

 - If a student is under 21, they can contact Covenant House PA directly (including pregnant/parenting youth) @ 215-951-5411.
 - If a student is under 18 and not involved in the foster care system, they
 can contact a federally funded <u>Basic Center</u> where they can reside for up
 to 21 days.
