

- Example: Carver Engineering & Science (7-12), Masterman (5-12), GAMP (5-12), Hill Freedman World Academy (6-12)
- Admission is not guaranteed to anyone.
 Filling out an application does not guarantee the request will be approved.
- Some schools do offer <u>SHADOW</u>
 <u>DAYS/OPEN HOUSES.</u> Parents must reach out to the schools.

School Selection - Participating Schools



Neighborhood schools that have space for students that live outside of their catchment area. Schools may have specialized programs. Citywide Schools

Open to the entire city and have specialized programs.

Criteria-Based Schools

Schools designed to provide challenging academic curriculum or programs.

Some criteria based schools have further specialization (e.g., Arts, STEM).

Academic Data



Students applying from **Non-District schools** must manually enter academic data into their application. This data must be verified using the District's **Common Transcript Form** (CTF) and must be completed and signed by a counselor or administrator from the previous or current school(s).

- Both pages of the completed form must be uploaded to the application.
- Report cards, transcripts, and progress reports from Non-District schools are not a substitute for the Common Transcript Form.
- Failure to include all required academic data (grades, attendance, and standardized assessment scores) in the required format may result in an incomplete application, which may be marked ineligible if applying to criteria-based schools.

- Only ONE letter grade is allowed for each subject area. If no letter grade is circled OR more than
 one letter grade is circled for a required subject, students will be made ineligible for grades.
- All students must have a letter grade for English or a letter grade for both Reading and Writing.
- Attendance must include a numerical value. If the "absences" fields are left blank OR are marked "N/A" for both academic years, students will be made ineligible for attendance.




Application Tips



Non District students <u>MUST</u> apply to 5 schools or programs.

- Applicants can update their selections and their ranking at any time during the application window.

Assessment Data

Applications for criteria-based schools require one English Language Arts/Reading and one Mathematics standardized assessment score from 2024 and 2025 calendar years.

- The applicant's Highest English Language
 Arts/Reading percentile score and the Highest
 Mathematics percentile score from 2024 and 2025
 calendar years will be used to determine eligibility
- Documentation is required to verify all provided scores. Uploaded assessment reports must be clear, legible, and complete digital copies that show
- English Language Arts/Reading Score(s) and/or Percentile(s)
- Mathematics Score(s) and/or Percentile(s)

Application Tips



For all students applying to criteria-based schools, failure to include all academic data (grades, attendance, transcripts, and approved standardized assessment score reports) may result in an incomplete application which may be marked ineligible and not be included in any evaluation processes for criteria-based schools.

Limiting options *will not* improve the chances of receiving an offer – in fact, the chances will decrease.

- Each applicant will receive either one offer or zero offers during the initial response phase. Prior years applicants could receive up to 5 offers.
 - Offers will be made based on the order in which an applicant ranked their five schools, the applicant's eligibility, and seats available at the school/program.
